There was a slight improvement in the number of papers submitted for evaluation for this volume 3 over volume 2. For this volume, a total of 39 papers were submitted for evaluation against the 35 papers submitted for volume 2, which translates to about 11% increase in the submission rate. However, out of the 39 manuscripts submitted for evaluation, a total of 26 papers were accepted after the peer-review exercise which translates to about 67% acceptance rate.

I would like to sincerely thank all our reviewers for rendering their selfless services to PSSN. Their valuable contributions have taken us this far in our journey towards improving statistical research in Nigeria.
